Money Spin

Materials

1. One *Spin and Draw* worksheet for every student
2. One *Money Spinner* worksheet for every two students
3. One large paper clip to accompany every spinner worksheet
4. A sharpened pencil for every student
5. (Optional) Silver and copper or gray and brown crayons for every student

How to Play

Spin the paper clip spinner on the *Money Spinner* worksheet. Look at the coin that the spinner landed on. On the *Spin and Draw* worksheet, draw a picture of the coin on the line next to its value. Take turns spinning and drawing with a partner. (Don't write down anything that your partner spins.) The first person to spin and draw five of the same coin and reach the finish line wins!

How to Spin

1. Place one paper clip over the gray circle that is in the center of the spinner worksheet. The gray circle should be visible through the middle of the tip.
2. Put the point of a sharpened pencil inside the tip of the paper clip.
3. Flick the paper clip as you would flick a standard spinner. Before playing, practice spinning to make the spinner go at least one full circle.
